Document upload: Each name and dates and places of birth, deaths, marriage and divorce must be supported by convincing evidence (such as vital records or other such documents). If you are missing this information, please prepare a statement supporting why the data you are providing is convincing evidence. You can separate the documents and create scans by generation, uploaded by section/generation or make one large scan at any point in the application. 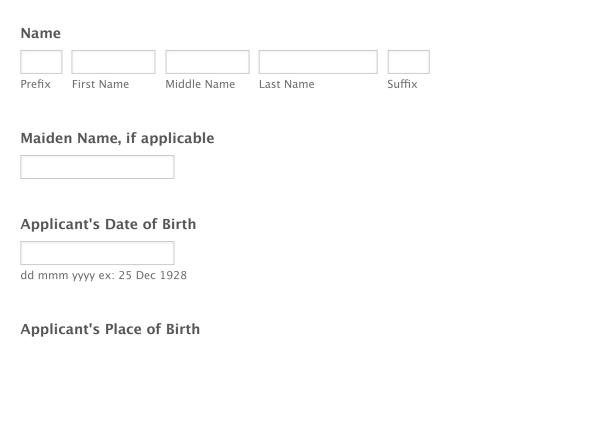

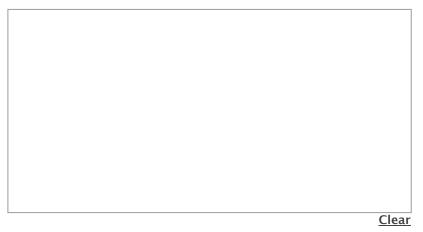
