Parent's Information (Generation 2); and Ancestor information for generations 3–9. At the end, we ask you to pay \$65.00 (full application) or \$25.00 (supplemental--for members adding additional members).

IMPORTANT NOTE BEFORE STARTING: For each generation, please assemble pictures or scans of documents supporting connections to each generation, date of birth, place of birth, date of death, place of death, marriage or divorce certificates, etc, before completing this application.

Document upload: Each name and dates and places of birth, deaths, marriage and divorce must be supported by convincing evidence (such as vital records or other such documents). If you are missing this information, please prepare a statement supporting why the data you are providing is convincing evidence. You can separate the documents and create scans by generation, uploaded by section/generation or make one large scan at any point in the application. If you chose one upload/one scan, please separate the documents by generations/section with a "title page" (Generation 1 or Enslavement Support, etc).

- **Names:** Use full or legal names. A nickname should be written in "quotes." Maiden names of all female ancestors must be included for the line leading back to the Honored Ancestor.
- **Dates:** List dates in dd mmm yyyy format (for example: 25 Dec 1928). If you're unsure of the day or year, use the words before, after, or about before the date.
